Six degrees of separation is the idea that all people are six or fewer social connections away from each other. On first consideration this seems a remarkable fact and yet, as we know from conversations and experience, it becomes clear quite quickly that this is exactly the case: connections, whether through family, friendship, career, hobby, interest or location make for a wonderful web of relationships and networks. Add in to this faith and the community of the Church and we have a very small world.

When I was at theological college a former archbishop of Uganda, Rwanda and Burundi had retired locally and was often present in the community. Among his many stories was his fond recollection of the martyr Janani Luwum, Archbishop of Uganda, who was killed in 1977. His love for a friend, colleague and brother in the faith was absorbing and found its expression in the poignancy of the Eucharist celebrated on the memorial of his death on 17th February each year.

As we remember his witness in the course of this month, we too are united with him and all saints ands martyrs of our own time. Degrees of separation are replaced by bonds of faith and love as we remember our sisters and brothers suffering, yet witnessing to the risen glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
