Born in 354 in north Africa, Augustine of Hippo studied in Carthage and Rome before moving to Milan to teach rhetoric. Although he had been raised as a Christian, Augustine became a Manichaean and then came under the influence of Neoplatonism, before being converted back to Christianity in his early 30s through the preaching of St Ambrose. He wrote an account of his conversion in his *Confessions*.

Having returned to Africa, Augustine established a monastic community and was ordained as a priest. Then, in 395 he became Bishop of Hippo Regius, where he remained until his death in 430 while the city was under siege from the Vandals.

It is impossible to overstate Augustine's influence on the western Church. He was a brilliant thinker, writer and preacher, but always a pastoral theologian writing in response to particular issues. He refuted the heresies of Manichaeism, Arianism and Pelagianism, and opposed the Donatist schism. He wrote *The City of God* in response to the sacking of Rome by the Visigoths. He was the most important Christian thinker since St Paul, and subsequent philosophy and theology largely consist of footnotes on Augustine.

However, none of this would have been possible without Augustine's mother Monica! From his rejection of the faith at the age of 17 until his eventual reconversion, Monica prayed daily for her son. She followed him to Milan and was present when he was baptised by Ambrose.

The Church celebrates Augustine on 28 August, the anniversary of his death; and we remember his mother Monica on the previous day, 27 August.
