

### Services and Music March 2025

In March, spring is finally upon us. On Ash Wednesday, which this year falls on 5 March, the Church begins the season of Lent. The word comes from the Old English word for spring, lencten, from the lengthening of the days. So spring is a time of refreshment and renewal, which may seem something of a paradox given that Lent is more usually associated with fasting and denial. But the purpose of the season of Lent is to allow us to go back to basics, focusing our hearts and minds on God by stripping away all those things that distract us from our true calling. In the early Church, this was the time when the catechumens prepared themselves for their baptism at Easter. It was also when penitents disciplined themselves prior to being readmitted at Easter into the fellowship of the Church. So we allow God to prune us during Lent in order that we may grow back more faithfully and more fruitfully.

At the beginning of Lent, our focus is on renewing our walk with Jesus. Only later will the cross come more sharply into view.
