Advent or Christmas? In December, the distinction between Advent and Christmas gets rather blurred. Advent is my favourite time of year – a rich, dark-edged season of anticipation and apprehension, looking forward to Christmas but also to Jesus' second coming at the end of all things. In theory we might keep Advent special by eschewing Christmas and especially Christmas carols until late on Christmas Eve.

But this is entirely unrealistic! For most people – including all of us – the Christmas festivities begin long before 25 December. Indeed, the first Christmas carols are sung here in the cathedral in November, before Advent has even begun.

The reality is that there are two different calendars in play, which is why for several weeks it is both Advent and Christmas. There is the church calendar of the liturgical purists, and there is the secular calendar of the rest of us. The first is important, but it would be wilful not to acknowledge the second. Changing gear rapidly from Advent to Christmas and back again is unsettling, but that's just how it is — and most of us get used to living with the tension.

Perhaps the point is that the Word becomes flesh suddenly and unexpectedly, in an unlikely place and an unlikely time. Interrupting Advent for Christmas reminds us that God bursts in dramatically and decisively, and not just when we are ready for him. Just think of all those carol services between now and Christmas as trailers for the coming main event. Happy (nearly) Christmas!
